

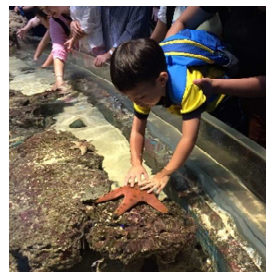


Thematic Activities

Children showed lots of enthusiasm, engagement and curiosity towards the Term 3 theme on "World of Animals". They had authentic learning experiences exploring with animals such as fish, butterfly, terrapin, rabbits and products from animals such as making their own purple cow milkshake. They learnt the characteristics of animals and made animal crafts and their habitats. They had a wonderful play experience at our Pet shop and Sea aquarium dramatic corner. The children also learnt about Singapore and our multi-cultural society.



K1 Class had an authentic learning experience at the **Butterfly Park and Insect Kingdom**. They interacted with live butterflies, stick insects, macaw and iguana. Children also discovered more about the metamorphosis of butterfly



At the **Singapore Zoo**, the **K2 children** explored endangered animals such as polar bear, tapir, otter etc. They also attended the **Splash Safari Show** where the sea lion performed their acrobatic dives and flips.



The **K1 & K2 children** visited the **National Museum** to understand more about Singapore in 1970s and 1980s. They discovered the popular family hangouts as well as cultural sites and historical land-marks along the Singapore River. They even experienced sitting in the olden day big cup musical game.

PG & N1 children experienced old kampong days during their visit to the **Animal Resort**. They were able to come close to live animals such as horse, rabbits, geese, etc. Children also showed their caring attitude to feed some of the animals.



The **N2 children** saw a diverse range of sea creatures in the **SEA Aquarium**. They were able to observe the characteristics, colours, size and movement of the various sea creatures. They even touched and felt the texture of sea star.

Hari Raya Puasa celebration - Children learnt about the various traditions that were being practiced during Hari Raya Puasa. Children were excited tasting Malay food and trying traditional clothes.



HPB vision screening workshop - The K1 and K2 children learnt about good eye care habits and myopia prevention. They participated in vision screening test.



HPB Roving Carnival - Children participated in various interactive exhibits to raise their awareness on the importance of leading a healthy lifestyle.



Teacher's Day Celebration - It is a great day to honour the teachers through playing games, receiving appreciation cards and gifts from children, parents and the centre.

Health Tip:
