## Thematic Activities

This is the last term of the year. The theme on nature allowed the children to build on their exploratory skills as they got out to explore nature to further extend their nature smart intelligences. The PG and N1 children explored the various weather conditions, the N2 children explored flowering plants, the K1 children explored on parts of a plant, the conditions of growing plants and the K2 children explored on tree and rainforest. The children's learning were enriched with outdoor learning journeys. 
#### Jacob Ballas Children Garden
