



Thematic Activities

Children developed their nature smart intelligence exploring Term 3 theme on "World of Animals". They had authentic learning journey to animal farm, zoo, aquarium and butterfly farm to observe the characteristics of animals. Children had opportunities to get close to interact with the animals. They demonstrated their respect and care for animals by feeding them. The centre also organised several activities to commemorate Singapore Bicentennial.



Learning Journey to St Hilda's Primary School (K2).

The K2 children gained positive experience on their transition to primary school. They toured and become aware of various facilities in the primary school such as computer lab, library, art room, P1 classroom, aquarium, dental clinic, general office, bookshop, staff room and playground. The children had a fun time playing various games and gained valuable experience buying food at the canteen.



The SEA Aquarium (N2).

The N2 children had an enriching and meaningful learning journey. They observed the characteristics of various sea creatures learnt in class. They happily mimicked the movements of dolphins, stingray and sea jellies. Using their sense of touch, they felt the texture of a sea star.



Butterfly and Insect Kingdom (K1).

The K1 children demonstrated their enthusiasm and curiosity throughout their learning journey. They witnessed a butterfly emerging from the chrysalis. The children also observed and touched butterflies, caterpillars, macaw, iguana, stick insects and observed the scorpion. The children displayed their nature smart intelligence and positive attitude towards living things.



Bicentennial Learning Journey (K1, K2)

As part of the children's learning about Singapore bicentennial, they visited the Bicentennial experience @ Fort Canning. Children were able to identify prominent leaders such as Sang Nila Utama and Sir Stamford Raffles. They witnessed how Singapore became successful and how Singaporean had made us proud.



The Animal Resort (PG)

At the Animal Resort, children experienced the old kampong days where they came close and interacted with animals such as horse, rabbits, guinea pigs, ducks, geese, chicken, guinea fowl, peacock, turkey, crowned crane etc. This allowed them to connect to what they had learnt in class.



Singapore Zoo (N1, K2).

During their learning journey to the zoo, the K2 children observed endangered animals such as otter, tapir, white tiger etc. and watched the sea lion performance. The N1 children observed zoo animals such as giraffe, zebra, monkey etc. They interacted with the animals by feeding the goats, stroking the pony and petting the rabbits. They also watched the Animal friends show and had the opportunity to get close to the dogs.

Racial Harmony Celebration



The children learnt how to practise racial harmony. They visited 5 stations (Chinese, Malay, Indian, Eurasian and Thai) to experience and appreciate the various cultures such as food, dance, games, costumes etc. Children became aware of our multiracial culture and multi-religious practices and learnt to respect one another.

National Day Celebration and Sports Carnival



The whole school community came together to celebrate National Day, commemorate Singapore Bicentennial and raise fund for President Challenge. Children embraced each other cultural practices through cultural dance performances. The children displayed good sportsmanship and motor skills during the sports relay and completed their race with pride. The children and parents had fun time at the various carnival stations playing traditional games. They also did their part to reduce climate change at the gardening station to plant and bring home their pot of plant. While they were happily savouring the traditional snacks and kacang puteh, they were reminded of the healthy eating guideline at the My Healthy Plate fishing station.

Preparing for Primary One Parent Workshop

The K2 parents learnt how the school curriculum prepared the children academically and the school's primary school transition program on how to prepare the children on the social and emotional aspect. Parents also picked up tips of how they can be involved to prepare their child and be alert to observe if their child does exhibit any sign of stress and anxiety and what are the possible coping skills.

Little Chef Session



Children continued to pursue the Thai culture and had their cookery session to make pumpkin custard (Kanom Fak Thong) to appreciate Thai dessert. Children measured the ingredients and followed step by step instructions to mash, mix and stir various ingredients till the final mixture is ready. They spooned the mixture into mini mould. After steaming, the pumpkin custard was ready for the children to savour during afternoon snack.
